Strategic Plan Update

Dear Carrollton First UMC family,

The Leadership Board of Carrollton First UMC approved our Strategic Plan for 2025 on February 4, 2025. This vision for our church has many facets for short, mid-range and long-term goals and I would like to briefly highlight how we are starting to live into this plan.

In the first 90 days we are seeking to grow our ministry team by adding a permanent accompanist for our Yellow Brick worship service and nursery care for many activities we host. Music is one of the most important parts of worship and having a dedicated individual who can easily step in and play the piano and organ is a must. We have been utilizing the gifts and talents of current members but they have made it known that help is needed. Further, having a staffed nursery at both the Bridge and Yellow Brick would also help to enhance our worship experience to allow parents with young children to feel ever more present in the service as they would not have to worry about their children causing interruptions.

We are also working to update our signage around our facility to make our space more user friendly and appealing to visitors and guests. This also includes improving the technology which we use to facilitate worship and communicate with members and the surrounding community. Discipleship is extremely important for our congregation to be equipped to be the hands and feet of Jesus Christ in our community and therefore we are continuing with implementing our usage of the 3DM program. This April, Kelsey and Devin Pitts and I will be attending the 3DM Immersion in New Haven, Indiana. This is a program that can help participants live into a Christ filled life.

A related goal is to provide more opportunities for members to participate in local missions. At the end of April you are invited to join in mission at Camp Aldersgate where we will help to get the camp ready to welcome children and youth this summer. We are also exploring other opportunities to get into the community to be the hands and feet of Christ. This could mean a trip to the Urban Mission in Steubenville or other individual projects here in Carrollton.

There are also many long-term goals that are related to improving our facilities, worship spaces and the ways in which we seek to make an impact in our community. The Leadership Board will continue working toward keeping you informed of the vision and work of our congregation. You can contact the church office for a copy of the 2025 Strategic Plan and I would love to have one-on-one conversations about the great possibilities that are in the future for Carrollton First UMC. Please do not hesitate to reach out to me directly to discuss, brainstorm and dream about what God could be doing through our faith community.
